

**NOTE:** The shaver socket will only operate when the light is switched on

#### LAMP REPLACEMENT

- 1) Switch off the electricity at the mains
- 2) Remove the diffuser and lamp as shown in figures 1 & 2.
- 3) Install new lamp and replace diffuser.

#### REPLACEMENT LAMP TYPE

Wattage: 60W or suitable low energy lamp  
Supply Voltage: 230V-240V  
Size: 284mm S15 Incandescent Strip lamp

#### CLEANING

Clean this product only with a soft dry cloth

Disconnect the power and clean the exterior only of this fitting with a moist (not wet) cloth.

The diffuser may be removed and washed in a mild detergent solution. Make sure the diffuser is completely dry before putting back on your light fitting.

Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners.

## General Information

### READ THIS FIRST:

Check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts listed on the front of this booklet. If not, contact the outlet where you bought this product.

This product contains glass, care must be taken when assembling, fitting or handling to prevent personal injury or damage to the product.

This product must be installed by a competent person in accordance with the current building and IEE wiring regulations.

As the buyer, installer and/or user of this product it is your own responsibility to ensure that this product is fit for the purpose for which you have intended it. Eterna Lighting cannot accept any liability for loss, damage or premature failure resulting from inappropriate use.

#### If in any doubt, consult a qualified electrician.

This product is designed and constructed according to the principles of the appropriate British Standard and is intended for normal domestic service. Using this fitting in any other environments may result in a shortened working life.


Switch off the mains before commencing installation and remove the appropriate circuit fuse or lock off MCB.

The lamp supplied with this fitting is a consumable part and therefore may be outside of any warranty offered.

#### This unit is suitable for indoor use only.

This product is suitable for use in living areas, and Bathroom dry (Outside) Zones only (see diagram below and current IEE Wiring Regulations for details). It is not suitable for Bathroom Zones 0, 1, 2, or other areas where contact with moisture is likely.

#### If being fitted in a bathroom a 30mA RCD must be used.



This product is designed for permanent connection to fixed wiring: this must be a suitable circuit (protected with the appropriate MCB or fuse).

This product is suitable for installation on surfaces with normal flammability e.g. wood, plasterboard and masonry. It is not suitable for use on highly flammable surfaces (e.g. polystyrene, textiles).

Before making fixing hole(s), check that there are no obstructions hidden beneath the mounting surface such as pipes or cables.

The chosen location of your new fitting should allow for the product to be securely mounted and safely connected to the mains supply (lighting circuit).

#### Do not cover the fitting.

When making connections ensure that the terminals are tightened securely and that no strands of wire protrude. Check that the terminals are tightened onto the bared conductors and not onto any insulation.

This product must be connected to earth termination.

#### WARNING: This product becomes hot!

This product is not intended to be used by children and persons with sensory, physical and/or mental impairments that would prevent them from using it safely.

#### IMPORTANT— Always switch off and isolate mains to the fitting before changing the lamp.

You are advised at every stage of your installation to double-check any electrical connections you have made. After you have completed your installation there are electrical tests that should be carried out, these tests are specified in the current IEE wiring and building regulations.

#### If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician.

## Installation

### INSTALLATION:

01. Remove the diffuser by pressing points shown in figure 1.
02. Remove the tube by pushing away from the pull cord end and lifting as shown in figure 2.
03. Place the fitting in the desired location and use as a template to mark the fixing points.
04. If fixing directly to the wall, drill holes and use wall plugs provided. See figure 3.
05. Lift off the back cover of the fitting and thread the supply cable through the hole in the middle.
06. Make connections to the fitting. See figure 4.
07. Replace the back cover.
08. Secure the fitting in place using the fixings supplied, if the fixings are not suitable to your installation use appropriate alternatives.
09. Insert the lamp and replace the diffuser as shown in figure 5. Please note the fitting will not work unless the diffuser is fitted.
10. Restore power and switch on.
